

RIDING ROUTE 66 GUIDED TOUR REGISTRATION FEES & WHATS INCLUDED

One Tour Participant/Double Occupancy :: \$700 (sharing one room with two beds with a roommate)

Two Tour Participants/Double Occupancy :: \$1,350 (a couple sharing one room with either one or two beds)

One Tour Participant/Single Occupancy :: \$700 (a private room without a roommate)

Your Tour Registration Fee does not include the following:

~Your Lodging: Fourteen Nights of Hotel/Motel accommodations at the recommended mixture of "newer" Hotels & "period" Route 66 Motels. An optional 1st Friday's Motel, before the tour, to visit Chicagoland & the "Begin" Route 66 Signpost. Lodging reservations & payments are your responsibility & will cost \$750 - \$925 for Double Occupancy & \$1500 - \$1850 for Single Occupancy & Couples. A list of the "Base Motels" & other recommended Motels will be supplied. While you are free to stay elsewhere, we will take the group to the base motels at the end of each day, you <u>must meet at the posted time each morning at the Base Motel</u> for daily briefings no matter where you stay. ~Your Meals: Most Motels have a small Continental Breakfast, other days we will stop for something for Breakfast as part of your Route 66 experience. Meals on average, will cost between \$45 to \$55 per person, per day, plus any alcohol, tax & tip

~Your Fuel: Depending on your vehicles m.p.g. & future inflation, your fuel cost should be around \$350 to \$475 one way. Motorcycles \$275 to 375. Also allow for oil or any repairs or towing costs for your vehicle. We will stop for pre-scheduled fuel stops, especially before crossing the desert areas ~Your Admission: The Petrified Forest National Park: \$25 per auto & \$20 per motorcycle (required) ~Your Admission: The Grand Canyon National Park: \$35 per auto & \$25 per motorcycle (optional) *Discounts for Veterans & for Seniors are explained at: www.nps.gov for both National Parks ~Optional Parking: The Santa Monica Pier: up to \$18 per vehicle. *<u>Handicap Placards park free</u> ~A voluntary Tip for some Route 66 Live Entertainment in Oklahoma

- ~Transporting yourself & vehicle from home to the Chicago area Base Motel
- ~Transporting yourself & vehicle from the Pasadena, CA, Base Motel to home
- ~Your Personal purchases or souvenirs, signs, t-shirts, camera media or sunscreen along 66
- ~Your Shipping of any excess baggage, souvenirs, etc ... back to your home, if flying
- ~Your Airfare to & from your home or your travel expenses to & from your home
- ~Your Transfers to & from the Airport Car Rental/Motorcycle Rental & to the Base Motel
- ~Your Vehicle Rental, Vehicle Turn-in, or any transfers to/from Airport or Hotels
- ~Your Shipping of your Vehicle/MC home, any Vehicle/MC Rental, or the required Liability Insurance ~Any Roadside Assistance, Towing or Trip Cancellation Insurance and/or Personal Travel Insurance
